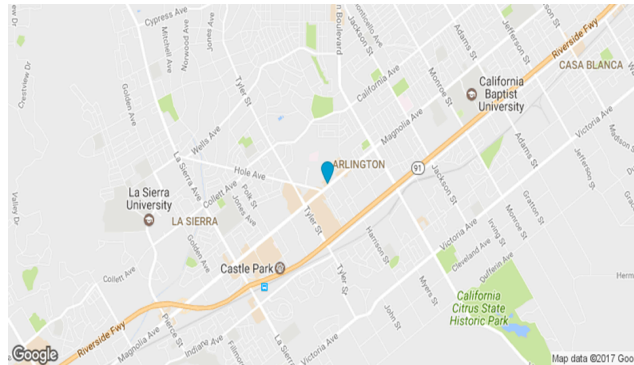

Phlebotomy Technician This is a 6.0 Semester Credit Unit (89 clock hours) program requires 3.2 weeks of training and provides the necessary knowledge, skill and attitude development. This is a study of blood specimens from health care clients for the purpose of testing and analysis. The course is comprised of a series of lectures, conferences and clinical experiences specifically designed for phlebotomy training. Successful completion of the course will allow students to sit for the National Phlebotomy Certification (NCCT) examinations.

Requirements for Certification

- A) All applicants should be of good moral character and have their high school diploma or equivalent.
- B) Be a graduate from an approved phlebotomy program of a school that is accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S.D.O.E. or has approval from the State's Dept. of Education. or Documentation of working as a phlebotomy technician for at least one or If currently holding a recognized national phlebotomy certification from another organization.

- C) All applicant must have completed 50 venipunctures and 10 capillaries.

Phlebotomy Technicians work directly with laboratory. Reference laboratories, hospitals, blood banks, and many physician offices depend on the phlebotomist to collect quality samples from the patient to produce the accurate laboratory results needed for important monitoring and diagnosis.
