EKG/ECG TECHNICIAN

EKG Technicians are responsible for performing electrocardiogram tests in hospitals and physician offices. These tests are used to monitor and record electrical impulses transmitted by the heart. This course provides the student with instructions for collecting information and data about a patient's heart using electrocardiography. Topics include: medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, identifying heart rhythms, operation of a 12-lead electrocardiograph machine, treadmill stress tests and use of a Holter monitor. This course assists students in preparation to take one of the national credentialing examinations, such as NCCT.

MONITOR TECHNICIAN



Monitor Technicians are responsible for the recognition and management of dysrhythmia's. The monitor technician class prepares the technician to interpret both normal and abnormal cardiac rhythms. The monitor technician often works in units such as Intensive care units, Telemetry units and Cardiac units. The technician is also responsible for observing, documenting, and reporting cardiac rhythms on monitored patients.
